

# PI DELTA CONSTITUTION

## ARTICLE I: Name and Purpose

Section 1: This organization shall be called the Delta Chapter of the Pi Delta National Honor Society.

Section 2: The purpose of the Society is to stimulate scholarship in podiatric medicine and the related health sciences for the advancement of the profession. The society further wishes to promote fraternalism among students and practitioners regardless of race, color, creed or national origin.

## ARTICLE II: Chapter Membership

The society shall consist of active, alumni and honorary members who are currently attending, graduates of, or associated with the William M. Scholl College of Podiatric Medicine.

## ARTICLE III: Selection of Members

Selection to membership in the Society shall be made in writing to the candidates.

## ARTICLE IV: Officers

The officers shall consist of a President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer. Officers will be elected annually in November of each academic year and resume office in January of that academic year. Candidates for office will be active members who will or are currently in their second year of podiatric education.

## ARTICLE V: Amendments

Section 1: Any amendments to the constitution shall require an affirmative vote by a majority of a quorum of the members of the society.

Section 2: A quorum shall be defined as 51% of the active members in attendance of the called meeting.

Section 3: New amendments shall be prepared in writing and presented to a member of the Executive Council a minimum of one week prior to the next meeting.
